

# Medical Students Need You!!

The UNM School of Medicine is seeking clinical preceptors for medical students and physician assistant students

- ❑ **BA/MD Summer Practicum Clinical Shadowing** (1<sup>st</sup> week in June – 4<sup>th</sup> week in June)
  - Time commitment – 8 hours per week for four weeks/ 32 hours' total
  - Students have just completed sophomore year in their undergraduate curriculum
  - Need physicians in Gallup, Farmington, Hobbs, Silver City, Taos, Las Cruces, and Las Vega
- ❑ **Continuity Clinic I** (last week of Jan – 1<sup>st</sup> week in May)
  - Time commitment – 1 afternoon/week for a minimum of six afternoons
  - Students are in the last half of their first year of medical school
  - Need primary care physicians in Albuquerque area only
- ❑ **Continuity Clinic II** (1<sup>st</sup> week of Sept – 1<sup>st</sup> week in Dec)
  - Time commitment – 1 afternoon/week for a minimum of six afternoons
  - Students are in first half of year 2
  - Need primary care physicians in Albuquerque area only
- ❑ **Practical Immersion Experience** (3<sup>rd</sup> week of June – last week of July)
  - Time commitment – minimum of 3 half days/week, maximum of 5 half days/week during the 8-week period
  - Students are between year 1 and year 2 medical school
  - Need primary care physicians (FP, IM, Pd, EM) throughout New Mexico
- ❑ **Continuity Clinic III** (scheduled throughout the year)
  - Time commitment – 1 afternoon twice a month over 12 months
  - Students are taking their required “third year” clerkships
  - Need all specialties and subspecialties in Albuquerque area only
- ❑ **Family Medicine Phase II Clerkship** (scheduled throughout the year)
  - Time commitment – minimum five half-days/week during the 8 week period, although preceptors may choose to do only four weeks of that time period
  - Need Family Practice physicians throughout New Mexico
- ❑ **Medicine in New Mexico** (scheduled throughout the year)
  - Time commitment – minimum of 96 hours over the 4-week rotation
  - Need all specialties and subspecialties throughout New Mexico
- ❑ **PA Continuity Clinic I and Continuity Clinic II**
  - Time commitment – Wednesday or Thursday afternoons from 1:00pm – 5:00pm
  - Need all specialties and primary care throughout New Mexico
