8. Medical Director

Dr. Jenkusky gave updates on the following topics:

- DEA and CMS Rules regarding Telemedicine.
- Safe Harbor recommendations have been implemented. The Board's licensing application professional practice questions have been updated to reflect those changes.
- Dr. Jenkusky is creating FAQ's relating to cosmetic procedures in medical spas and eventually the Board's rules will be amended. The Board of Nursing will be promulgating regulations regarding Medical Spas in November 2023. Dr. Carson suggested the Board include a dermatologist who may be able to assist with this.
- Board staff is currently working on the planned merger of the licensing of Podiatrists with the Board
 effective July 1. Names have been submitted to form the Podiatry Advisory Committee and Amanda
 Quintana is working on the Board's regulations for podiatrists.
- The Board's promulgated rules from the passage of House Bill 384 will go into effect July 10 via emergency rule making and will be in place for 90 days. The Board will hold a formal rule hearing on these rules at the September Interim Board Meeting.
- Endorsement of FSMB policies, including physicians changing specialties, will be reviewed and discussed at a future board meeting.
