7. Reports- [Portions may be closed**]

Executive Director

Interim Executive Director, Monique Parks informed the Board that there are currently only two vacant positions within NMMB and shared that the rest of the open positions have been filled and that the

Investigations department is fully staffed. Mrs. Parks also mentioned that there are upcoming meetings scheduled between the Investigations department and the Board members to go over current information pertaining to organization of investigation cases.

Board Chair

Board Chair, Dr. Carson shared with the Board that there will be some upcoming meetings scheduled soon with multiple Senators to go over recent ideas and information. Dr. Carson also informed the Board that an additional question was recently added to the licensing application regarding the Medical Review Commission Panel and stated that there were quite a few licensees who are willing to participate in the panel. Dr. Carson let the Board know that there will be a lot of questions rising regarding malpractice and the Board's reporting on malpractice in the upcoming legislative session and asked the Board to provide any ideas that they might have regarding reporting. Dr. Carson concluded her report by asking the Board to review the possibility of the NMMB utilizing what is called a Public Letter of Concern. She shared with the Board that the utilization of this document would require a statutory change and that the letter would be reportable to NPDB but as a non-disciplinary report. The letter would serve as an in-between an Advisory Letter and a Reprimand. She informed the Board that several other states utilize this type of document and asked the Board to consider its use. Several Board members agreed that it could be a valuable tool for the NMMB, provided it is applied consistently.

Medical Director

NMMB Medical Director, Philip Sheilds spoke to the Board about malpractice reports from the NPDB and mentioned that he believes that there will need to be a clear policy to state that the reports from the NPDB will not be used solely to initiate an investigation or reprimand for a licensee but that they would be used in a broader sense of looking at the entirety of a licensee's practice history. He noted to the Board that he provided a policy for the Board's review and shared a proposed algorithm with the Board for approval. Dr. Sheilds also mentioned that a large problem with NPDB reports on malpractice is timeliness as there are some instances that cases are being finalized years later in some cases. He further stated that the purpose of this policy is to assure the public as well as licensees that this will not initiate investigation cases to be opened but more to explain how NMMB will be utilizing the reports. Dr. Sheilds then stood for questions and comments from the Board and addressed updates, edits and changes to the policy provided.

MOTION was made by Dr. Carson to approve the NPDB Policy – Review of Malpractice Reports to the National Practitioners Data Bank with the changes discussed. **SECONDED:** Ms. Daniels. **YES:** Dr. Carson, Dr. Barrett, Ms. Daniels, Ms. Medrano, PA Onorato, Dr. Richards, Dr. Roth, and Dr. Scoggins. **EXCUSED:** Dr. Reidy, Dr. Unverzagt. **MOTION CARRIED.**

1 CHAIR CARSON MD: All right. This hearing
2 will please come to order. I am Karen Carson MD and
3 chair of the New Mexico Medical Board. I will be acting
4 as presiding officer for this rule hearing pursuant to
5 NMSA 1978 61-6-1(B) in the interest of the public health
6 safety and welfare and to protect the public from
7 improper, unprofessional, incompetent and unlawful
8 practice of medicine. It is necessary to provide laws
9 and rules controlling the granting and use of the
10 privilege to practice medicine and to establish a
11 medical board to implement and enforce the laws, rules
12 and regulations.

13 The mission of the Board is to promote
14 excellence in the practice of medicine through
15 licensing, discipline and rehabilitation. The purpose
16 of this hearing is to amend to the existing NMAC rules
17 16.10.2.10 and 16.10.4.8 to add additional language to
18 both rules, occupational and professional licensing
19 rules. As a general summary, the New Mexico Medical
20 Board regular board meeting, held on November 6th
21 through 7th, 2025, and February 5th through 6th, 2026,
22 the Board discussed the addition of language to the
23 existing NMAC rules 16.10.2.10 and 16.10.4.8 to include
24 additional language pertaining to certified -- that
25 should be continuing medical education requirements and

1 detailed information on the types of applications that
2 will be accepted for expedited licensure through the New
3 Mexico Medical Board. We're going to start with an
4 attendance sheet, and may I remind everyone to sign the
5 attendance sheet that will later be entered as an
6 exhibit into the record of this hearing. Attendees via
7 Zoom, your names and titles will be added to the
8 transcript.

9 Would Ms. Padilla call the role of board
10 members present for this hearing.

11 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Carson?

12 CHAIR CARSON MD: Carson here.

13 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Barrett?

14 DR. BARRETT: Barrett here.

15 MS. PADILLA: Daniels?

16 MS. DANIELS: Daniels here.

17 MS. PADILLA: Ms. Medrano?

18 MS. MEDRANO: Medrano here.

19 MS. PADILLA: PA Onorato?

20 PA ONORATO: Onorato here.

21 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Reidy (phonetic)?

22 (No Response.)

23 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Ricards?

24 DR. RICHARDS: Richards here.

25 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Roth?

1 DR. ROTH: Roth here.

2 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Scoggins.

3 DR. SCOGGINS: Scoggins here.

4 MS. PADILLA: Dr. Unverzagt?

5 Dr. UNVERZAGT: Unverzagt here.

6 CHAIR CARSON MD: Thank you. Let the record
7 show that Tom Banner, the board's attorney, is present
8 to advise the Board. For the record, would the members
9 of the audience please introduce themselves. State your
10 affiliation and inform the Board if they wish to present
11 testimony.

12 MR. RAIN: Good evening, honorable board
13 members. I am David Rain, the attorney for
14 Dr. Cardenas. Dr. Cardenas is subject to the
15 contemplated action, lotus --

16 CHAIR CARSON MD: Mr. Rain, I am going to
17 stop you really quick here. We are doing a rule
18 hearing. We will -- we will deal with disciplinary
19 actions later. So according to the agenda, this is the
20 rule hearing right now. So if you have testimony
21 regarding the rule hearing that we are reviewing right
22 now...

23 MR. RAIN: Okay. I understand now.

24 MS. PADILLA: Anyone from the public body
25 that wishes to give testimony regarding the rule

1 hearing?

2 (No response.)

3 CHAIR CARSON MD: All right. Thank you.
4 Okay. We're going to move into exhibits, and the public
5 hearing is now open.

6 Ms. Padilla, at this time, do you have any
7 exhibits to introduce into evidence?

8 MS. PADILLA: I have the following exhibits
9 to enter into evidence: Exhibit Number 1, proposed
10 amendment to existing Rule 16.10.2.10. Exhibit
11 Number 2, proposed amendment to existing Rule 16.10.4.8.
12 Exhibit Number 3, the legal notices that were published
13 in the Albuquerque Journal on May 5th, 2026, meeting the
14 advanced notice requirement for a public role hearing.
15 Exhibit Number 4, the legal affidavits of publications
16 that were published in the New Mexico register on May 5,
17 2026, meeting the advance notice requirement for a
18 public role hearing. Exhibit Number 5, the legal
19 notices that were published on the Sunshine Portal on
20 May 5, 2026, meeting the advanced notice requirement for
21 a public rule hearing; and Exhibit Number 6, public
22 comment from a New Mexico Hospital Association.

23 CHAIR CARSON MD: Thank you. Are there any
24 questions from the Board members? Seeing none,
25 Exhibit 1 through 6 are hereby admitted into the record.

1 Any person wishing to testify and who wishes to submit
2 evidence for their comments shall do so when they are
3 recognized to testify. Each document submitted shall be
4 introduced as an exhibit to the record. Board members
5 will be permitted to ask questions before I rule on the
6 admissibility of the evidence. Upon admissibility, each
7 exhibit will be marked and numbered and will be entered
8 into the record.

9 Would anyone wish to comment on the
10 proposed changes to the Board's rules that have been
11 posted and advertised for 180 days prior to this hearing
12 and that I just summarized on the record? Ms. Medrano?

13 MS. MEDRANO: Madam Chair, I apologize.
14 Question regarding the public comment that has been
15 received thus far, we have been discussing whether that
16 will be adopted or not.

17 CHAIR CARSON MD: Only if you have a concern
18 regarding the public comment. If you feel that we need
19 to change the rules regarding that comment, then we
20 would go back and we would not adopt the rules and work
21 on them again.

22 MS. MEDRANO: Okay. Thank you.

23 CHAIR CARSON MD: All right. Do we have
24 anybody else that has any questions or statements?

25 MS. MEDRANO: No.

1 CHAIR CARSON MD: All right. Seeing none, I
2 will close the hearing. At this time, the attendance
3 sheet shall be marked as an exhibit and entered into the
4 record.

5 MS. PADILLA: I ask for admission of the
6 attendance sheet as Exhibit Number 7.

7 CHAIR CARSON MD: Exhibit Number 7 is hereby
8 admitted into the record. The comments submitted in
9 discussion heard during the rule hearing will be
10 considered and will be discussed further by the Board
11 during the open meeting following the rule hearing. The
12 proposed rule will be voted on by the Board at that
13 time. Any rules adopted by the Board will be filed at
14 State Records and Archives in accordance with the State
15 Rules Act and New Mexico registered publication
16 deadlines. The adopted rule becomes effective 30 days
17 after they are filed at Records and Archives. The
18 regular meeting of the Board will become -- will begin
19 immediately following the rule hearing. Let the record
20 show that this hearing was adjourned at 4:17 p.m.

21 All right. We are going to move on to our
22 new rule 16.10.2.10, and I am asking for a motion and a
23 second to adopt that rule for expedited licensure.

24 MS. DANIELS: I will second it, Daniels.

25 CHAIR CARSON MD: Did I get a first motion

1 for that? I didn't hear it.

2 DR. SCOGGINS: I will move, Scoggins.

3 CHAIR CARSON MD: Thank you.

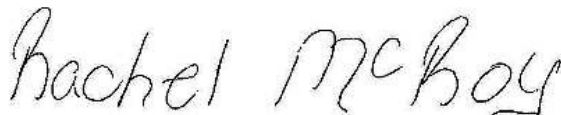
