11. Presentations

EBAS- Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services

Bradley Guye provided an overview of EBAS, an ethics assessment program designed to promote behavioral change and reduce repeat violations among regulated professionals. Mr. Guye

discussed the concept of “ethics drift,” explaining how minor ethical violations can progress into more serious conduct through justification, repetition, normalization, and concealment.

Mr. Guye stated that EBAS serves more than 150 regulatory boards across 41 states and 37 professions. The program uses occupation-specific, scenario-based essay assessments administered at Prometric testing centers. The assessments are based on real-life disciplinary matters and evaluate a licensee’s understanding and application of ethical standards.

Mr. Guye explained that EBAS may be incorporated into disciplinary orders or consent agreements, with assessment results provided directly to the regulatory board. He distinguished EBAS from traditional continuing education by emphasizing that EBAS assesses whether a licensee understands the underlying ethical issues rather than simply confirming course completion.

12. Reports

Executive Director

Interim Executive Director, Monique Parks provided an update on several Board initiatives and activities. RLD has requested that the NMMB establish its own Salesforce organization, with a goal of completing the transition by FY2028. The Board is also implementing software to streamline IPRA requests and support Board agendas and meeting minutes.

Mrs. Parks reported on ongoing coordination with Board leadership, HPWP, legislators, the Hospital Association, and the Senate Finance Committee regarding Board operations, outreach, the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC), and future funding needs. The Board will participate in upcoming legislative and stakeholder meetings, including the Human and Health Services Committee meeting on August 21 in Gallup and the Hospital Association meetings in September and November.

Mrs. Parks also proposed an interim Board meeting for September 9 at 3:00 p.m. to address cases requiring timely Board review and action. The Executive Director also recognized Board staff for their continued hard work, professionalism, and commitment to improving Board processes.

Chair Report

Dr. Carson, NMMB Board Chair, took a moment to update the Board on legislative and funding discussion, including the need for full-time IT support, a part-time Public Information Officer, and additional IT resources related to proposed legislation and Interstate Medical Licensure Compact implementation. Dr. Carson stated that discussions will continue with the LFC, House Appropriations, and legislators regarding these needs.

Dr. Carson also informed the Board about proposed changes to physician assistant practice authority and the potential establishment of a satellite office in Albuquerque. Staff will continue discussions regarding both matters. Dr. Carson took a moment to touch base on the Executive Director position; she informed the Board that the position's salary range is low and that staff is exploring options for a potential reclassification with the Governor's office.

Finally, Dr. Carson shared an update on the State Medical Board of Ohio's complaint triage and quality assurance process, including staff-led triage, standardized procedures, and checklists. The Board discussed adapting similar processes in New Mexico and incorporating regular quality improvement reviews of licensing and investigations data into quarterly reports.

Medical Director

Dr. Shields, NMMB Medical Director, provided the Board with an update on the status of policy revisions, including the Med Spa Policy. Dr. Shields also reported that he is developing a Letter of Concern and requested feedback from the Board members.

Dr. Shields further reported that he is working on outreach efforts with hospitals.

Finance

Lusan Leyba, CFO, presented the following financial statistics to the Board.

As of June 30, 2025, the budget revenue status is as follows:

Expenditures from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025, totaled \$3,171,677.74, representing 88.02% of the total budgeted expenditures (Operating Budget: \$3,353,400 +FB \$250,000.00= \$3,603,400).

Revenues collected during the same period amounted to \$3,673,919.16, which is 109.56% of the budgeted revenue target.
