Charles William Bennett, M.D. – MD2016-0080 – *Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of violations of of NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(7) (2025), habitual or excessive use of intoxicants or drugs; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(15) (2025), the use of a false, fraudulent or deceptive statement in a document connected with the practice of a licensee; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(19) (2025), repeated similar negligent acts or a pattern of conduct otherwise described in this section or in violation of a board rule; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(21)(c) (2025), failure to report to the board any adverse action taken against the licensee by a health care entity; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(23) (2025), failure to furnish the board, its investigators or representatives with information requested by the board; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(26) (2025), injudicious prescribing, administering or dispensing of a drug or medicine; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(33) (2025), improper management of medical records, including failure to maintain timely, accurate, legible and complete medical records; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(36) (2025), interaction with physicians, hospital personnel, patients, family members or others that interferes with patient care or could reasonably be expected to adversely impact the quality of care rendered to a patient; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(29) (2025), conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice medicine or detrimental to the best interests of the public; NMAC 16.10.10.13 failure to report adverse action; Applicable Board rules found at Title 16, Chapter 10, NMAC (as amended); and/or Provisions of the Code of Medical Ethics of the American Medical Association (2014-2015 Ed.) as adopted by the Board at 16.10.8.9 NMAC. Charles William Bennett, M.D. – MD2016-0080 – *Notice and Order of Summary Suspension was issued based on evidence that the Board possesses indicating that Dr. Bennett poses a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if continuing to practice medicine. Such evidence, if not rebutted at a later hearing, will justify the Board in imposing further suspension or revocation of Dr. Bennett's license to practice medicine in the State of New Mexico and/ or other disciplinary action taken against Dr. Bennett by the Board. It is hereby ordered that Dr. Bennett's New Mexico license to practice as a physician in the State of New Mexico is hereby Summarily Suspended until further Order of the Board. (Entered 04.09.2026)*

Ian Gregory Reight, M.D. – APPLICANT – *Stipulation and Order for Withdrawal of Initial Application was issued based on stipulated findings of fact and conclusions of law found in a New Mexico Medical Board (NMMB) investigation conducted in relation to Dr. Reight's Application for Licensure. At this time, Dr. Reight desires to withdraw the Application while under investigation. It is hereby ordered that Dr. Reight's Initial Application to the Board for a license to practice medicine as a physician in the State of New Mexico is withdrawn while under investigation. Rodney Wayne Sholty, M.D. – APPLICANT – *Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of Section 61-6-15(D)(29) and 16.10.8.8 NMAC, unprofessional or dishonorable conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice or detrimental to*

the best interests of the public; Section 61-6-11(A), an applicant to the Board who is not a person of good moral character; 16.10.8.9(A,B) NMAC, a violation of the Code of Medical Ethics of the American Medical Association adopted by the Board as the ethical standards for the practice of medicine in New Mexico, more specifically a lack of respect for the law. Zachary David Urdang, M.D. – APPLICANT – Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of violations of Section 61-6-15(D)(15) the use of a false, fraudulent or a deceptive statement in a document connected with the practice of a licensee; 16.10.8.8(G) NMAC making or signing false documents; Section 61-6-15(D)(33) improper management of medical records, including the failure to maintain accurate and complete medical records; 16.10.8.8(H) NMAC dishonesty; Section 61-6-15(A, D) the applicant is guilty of unprofessional or dishonorable conduct; Section 61-6-15(D)(29) conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice; Section 61-6-15(D)(12) manifest incapacity or incompetence to practice as a licensee; 16.10.8.9(A,B) NMAC the American Medical Association Code of Medical Ethics. **(Entered 05.08.2026)**

Jeffrey Lewis Glass, M.D. – APPLICANT – Stipulation and Order for Withdrawal of Initial Application was issued based on stipulated findings of fact and conclusions of law found in a New Mexico Medical Board (NMMB) investigation conducted in relation to Dr. Reight's Application for Licensure. At this time, Dr. Glass desires to withdraw the Application while under investigation. It is hereby ordered that Dr. Glass's Initial Application to the Board for a license to practice medicine as a physician in the State of New Mexico is withdrawn while under investigation. **(Entered 05.08.2026)**

Jason Dutming Wong, M.D. – MD2023-1027 – Stipulation and Order of Reprimand was issued based on a New Mexico Medical Board (NMMB) investigation that was conducted based on allegations of violations for the MPA. Specifically, an allegation of the violation of Section 61-6-15(D)(36) NMSA 1978 (interaction with physicians, hospital personnel, patients, family members, others, that interferes with patient care or could reasonably be expected to adversely impact the quality of care rendered to a patient.) The Board has endorsed the opportunity for Dr. Wong to resolve these allegations by accepting a letter of reprimand from the Board for conduct which was contrary to Section 61-6-15(D)(36) NMSA 1978 and by complying with the conditions set forth in the Order. **(Entered 05.14.2026)**

Neil Hemant Joshi, M.D. – MD2025-0537 – Order of Release from Stipulation of Licensure was issued to Respondent stating that the terms, conditions, and/or limitations placed on the Respondent's license to practice under Stipulation of Licensure are hereby vacated and removed. **(Entered 05.14.2026)**

Quinn Philip Stein, G.C. – GC2022-006 – Order of Release from Stipulation of Licensure was issued to Respondent stating that the terms, conditions, and/or limitations placed on the Respondent's license to practice under Stipulation of Licensure are hereby vacated and removed. **(Entered 05.14.2026)**

Sajad Zalzal, M.D. – MD2019-0210 – Order of Release from Stipulation of Licensure was issued to Respondent stating that the terms, conditions, and/or limitations placed on the Respondent's license to practice under Stipulation of Licensure are hereby

vacated and removed. (Entered 05.14.2026)

Jennifer Lynn McCain, D.O. – A-2125-18 – Order of Release from Stipulation of Licensure was issued to Respondent stating that the terms, conditions, and/or limitations placed on the Respondent’s license to practice under Stipulation of Licensure are hereby vacated and removed. (Entered 05.15.2026)

Teresa Marie Scoggins, P.A. – PA2026-0052 – Stipulation of Licensure and Non-Disciplinary Order was issued based on an Application for Licensure submitted to the New Mexico Medical Board by PA Scoggins. The Board reviewed the application and voted to approve licensure subject to certain stipulations. PA Scoggins is granted a license to practice as a physician assistant limited to and exclusively to the practice of Neurology subject to a proctorship with mandatory quarterly reports submitted to the Board for one calendar year. Shiva Sharma, M.D. – MD2022-1124 – Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of violations of NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(29) (2025), conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice medicine or detrimental to the best interests of the public; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(21)(c) (2025), failure to report to the board any adverse action taken against the licensee by a health care entity; NMAC 16.10.10.13 failure to report adverse action; Applicable Board rules found at Title 16, Chapter 10, NMAC (as amended); and/or Provisions of the Code of Medical Ethics of the American Medical Association (2014-2015); NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(38) willfully or negligently divulging privileged information or a professional secret. David Brannan Durham, M.D. – MD2008-0595 – Notice of Summary Suspension was issued based on evidence that the New Mexico Medical Board possesses indicating that Dr. Durham poses a clear and immediate danger to the public health and safety if he continues to practice medicine. Such evidence, if not rebutted at a later hearing, will justify the Board in imposing further suspension or revocation of Dr. Durham’s license to practice medicine in the state of New Mexico and/or other disciplinary action taken against him by the Board. David Brannan Durham, M.D. – MD2008-0595 – Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of violations of NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(8), fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a license or renewal; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(15), use of false, fraudulent, or deceptive statements in documents connected with the practice of the licensee; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(18), conduct that is likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(19), a pattern of conduct involving wrongful acts; NMSA 1978, Section 61-6-15(D)(29), conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice or detrimental to the best interests of the public; Rule 16.10.14 NMAC, controlled substance prescribing standards; Applicable Board rules found at Title 16, Chapter 10, NMAC; and/or Provisions of the Code of Medical Ethics of the American Medical Association as adopted by the Board at Rule 16.10.8.9 NMAC. Junaid Abdul Ahmed, M.D. – MD2025-0004 – Stipulation of License and Order of Reprimand was issued based on a New Mexico Medical Board (NMMB) investigation that was conducted based on allegations of violations for the Medical Practice Act. Dr. Ahmed is hereby REPRIMANDED for conduct which was contrary to Section 61-6-

15(D)(21)(a) NMSA 1978 (failure to report to the Board any adverse action taken against the license by another licensing jurisdiction) and Section 61-6-15D NMSA 1978 (14) (discipline imposed on a licensee by another licensing jurisdiction) and shall pay a fine in the amount of \$150.00 to the Board within six (6) months of the endorsement of this order and it is noted that Respondent has already paid the fine in full. Robert M Martin, P.A. – PA2002-0009 – *Notice of Contemplated Action was issued based on allegations of violations of Section 61-6-15(D)(29) and 16.10.8.8 NMAC, unprofessional or dishonorable conduct unbecoming in a person licensed to practice or detrimental to the best interests of the public; 16.10.8.9(A,B) NMAC, a violation of the Code of Medical Ethics of the American Medical Association adopted by the Board as the ethical standards for the practice of medicine in New Mexico, more specifically a lack of respect for the law; Section 61-6-15D(21)(f) and (g) failure to report to the Board any adverse action taken against a licensee by a law enforcement agency or a court; and Section 61-6-15D(23) failure to furnish the Board, its investigators or representatives with information requested by the Board. Shashwat Pandhi, M.D. – MD2020-0592 – *Interim Stipulated Order for Inactivation of License While Under Investigation was issued based on the Board's reasonable cause to believe that Dr. Pandhi is in violation of the Medical Practice Act or other applicable law and/or that immediate Board action to protect the public health, safety and welfare is appropriate under the circumstances of a pending New Mexico Medical Board (NMMB) investigation.
